

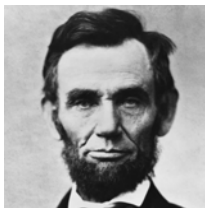
Cherry Blossoms

Day 1: Today we'll all get acquainted as we travel eastward into Iowa for our first night's stay. Overnight Bettendorf, Iowa.

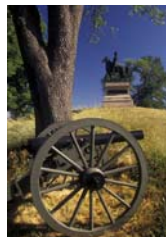
Day 2: Traveling further east today, we will visit Springfield, IL, and the home, museum & tomb of Abraham Lincoln. Then it is off to our overnight destination of Indianapolis, Indiana.



Day 3: Our stop today will be the National Air Force Museum at Wright Patterson AFB in Dayton, OH. This is the oldest and largest aviation



museum in the world! We will also travel onto the base for a guided tour of the Presidential Hangar to see past Air Force 1 planes. Overnight Saint Clairesville, Ohio.



Day 4: We'll step back in time today when we tour the Gettysburg Battlefield. We'll have



lunch at a Civil War home before traveling to Manassas, Virginia, which will be home for the next four nights.

Days 5-6-7: Our first day in Washington, DC, will begin with a tour of the Capitol Building, and a possible tour of the White House, depending on current security restrictions. The afternoon will be spent browsing the Smithsonian Air and Space



Museum, the Museum of Natural History, & the Museum of American History, all of which are filled with countless and unimaginable artifacts of our nation's history. On Day 6, we will visit Mt. Vernon, and the Arlington Cemetery. On Day 7, we'll be joined by a local step-on guide who will take us all around our nation's capital to see the many memorials that it is so famous for, including the Kennedy Center. We will overnight these three nights in Manassas, Virginia.



Day 8: After bidding a fond farewell to Washington, DC, we leave for home today, with our overnight in Grayson, Kentucky.

Day 9: Today we begin with a guided tour of the Waveland Mansion. Built in 1847 by the grandnephew of Daniel Boone, the house, slave quarters, smokehouse and ice house exemplify the social & economic climate of the times. Travel will continue to Mount Vernon, Illinois, for our overnight stay.



Day 10: Today, we will visit the Harry S. Truman Library and Museum. The museum consists of approximately 30,000 objects associated with the historical events of President Truman. Don't forget your cameras as the museum allows non-flash photography. We will be staying overnight in Saint Joseph, Missouri.



Day 11: We're homeward bound today; it's hard to believe our time together has come to an end. You'll have time today to exchange addresses and phone numbers with your new friends. Our trip concludes this evening with warm goodbyes to our many new friends and an abundance of memories.
