**Day 1:** You'll meet new friends today as we spend the day traveling to our overnight destination of Buffalo, WY.

**Day 2:** After we enjoy breakfast at the hotel, board the bus headed for our next overnight at Grant Village in Yellowstone National Park.

**Day 3:** Deemed the world's first national park, Yellowstone National Park is larger than Delaware & Rhode Island put together and features one of the world's largest calderas and over 300 geysers—most notably Old Faithful. **Day 4:** This morning we head out to Ontario, OR. Along the way, we will stop by the Crater of the Moon Park for a picnic lunch. Overnight Ontario, OR.

**Day 5:** Our first stop today is the Bonneville Lock & Dam where our guide will explain the history and explain how the plant produces electricity. We will also view the "fish ladder" where, hopefully, we'll see fish migrating up stream. Afterwards, we will take the scenic drive along the Columbia River Gorge Highway to Multnomah Falls. Overnight Portland, OR.



**Day 6:** A guided tour of Portland begins our day. Included is a stop at the Portland Int'l Test Gardens, world-renowned for housing a diverse and expansive collection of rare and beautiful roses. This afternoon includes a visit to Salem, OR, and the Redhawk Winery for a tour and tasting. Overnight Salem, OR.

**Day 7:** Mission Mill Museum produced woolen products from 1889-1962 and will be our first stop today. After the tour we will head to Grants Pass, OR, for supper (on Prairie Coach!) and our overnight.



**Day 8:** This morning finds us headed south to the Jedediah Smith Redwood State Park where some of the oldest and

tallest Redwoods reside. Upon exiting the park, you'll enjoy the ocean-front view as we travel north on Scenic Hwy 101. Overnight Bandon, OR.

**Day 9:** We will travel further up the coast today with stops in Cape Perpetua, Siuslaw National Forest and Old Towne Florence before stopping for our overnight in Newport, OR.

**Day 10:** Heading still further north today we visit Cape Meares Scenic Viewpoint and stop at Mo's Restaurant in Cannon Beach. Be sure to try the award-winning Clam Chowder! After lunch it's on to Ft Clatsop for a guided tour of the Lewis & Clark winter encampment. Overnight Longview, WA.



**Day 11:** At 8:32a.m. Sunday, May 18, 1980,

Mt. Saint Helens erupted forever changing the landscape around the mountain. This morning we go to the visitor's center where staff will answer all your questions regarding the volcano. The Space Needle is next up where you'll delight in the spectacular view of the Seattle skyline! Tonight you can see the lights of Seattle on our Argosy Dinner Cruise. Overnight Seattle, WA.



**Day 12:** Today, we have a guided city tour of Seattle ending at the Pike Place Farmers Market. Overnight Spokane, WA.

**Day 13:** Today, we embark on a scenic drive through Idaho and Montana, stopping in Missoula on the way to our overnight in Billings, MT.



**Day 14:** On our journey eastward, we will stop at the Little Big Horn Battlefield. Overnight Rapid City, SD.

**Day 15:** It's hard to believe that our excursion to the northwest is almost over. As we head for home today, we make a stop at the Minute Man Missile Site



for a very informative tour. We hope to see you on another Prairie Coach tour soon!
